The Pretrial Diversion Program is a program of the Courts made available to you on a voluntary basis. Your successful participation will result in a recommendation that the charge(s) now pending against you be dismissed. In order to become enrolled as a participant, you must agree to the following conditions:

1. I will not commit any further violations of the law.
2. I will attend all appointments as arranged with my Pretrial Officer.
3. I will report any changes in my address or phone number to my Pretrial Officer within three business days.
4. I will report and cooperate with any agencies that I am referred to by my Pretrial Officer.
5. I will pay any assessed program fee in the form of a **money order** or **certified/cashier's check** made payable to **Kentucky State Treasurer** and will submit said payment to the local Pretrial Services office.
6. If ordered to pay restitution, I will follow the Court's order and pay the amount in its entirety.
7. I will comply with all conditions ordered by the Court.
8. I further agree to the following conditions:
  - 1.) \$100.00 Diversion Fee
  - 2.) 12 Community Service Hours
  - 3.) Complete Cognitions Critical Thinking Class
 Completion Deadline: APRIL 9, 2025

Further, by signing this agreement, I acknowledge/understand the following:

1. I understand that this program is entirely voluntary.
2. I understand that I am required to comply with this agreement, and it will remain in effect for up to 3 months.
3. I understand that I may withdraw in writing from the program at any time. I further understand that if I withdraw, my case will be referred back to Court and prosecution of the charges may resume against me as if there had been no agreement.
4. I understand that by participating in this program I am waiving my right to a speedy trial.
5. I acknowledge that failure to fulfill any of these obligations may be considered sufficient reason by the Pretrial Officer, Judge, Prosecutor and/or Director of the program to proceed with prosecution for this offense.
6. I understand that if I demonstrate that I can and will behave in a law-abiding manner, a dismissal recommendation will be made and if accepted by the court, my charges will be dismissed and I will have the ability to expunge my record(s) in accordance with the applicable statute.
